- > **Case management:** Helping residents set goals and access support and services to accomplish them.
- > **Mental health support:** Coordinating care, treatment, and support to address mental health issues.
- > **Substance abuse treatment:** Coordinating care, treatment, and support to address substance use issues.
- > **Job & life skills training:** Equipping residents with skills for inside and outside the workplace.
- > **Eligibility assistance:** Helping residents access and apply for various benefits for which they are entitled.
- > **Peer support & recreation:** Providing tailored support and engagement activities to build community.
- > **Food assistance:** Coordinating with partners to help residents access food.

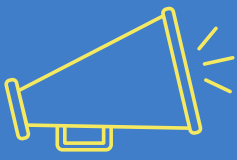
